

Appointments with a Doctor

You can arrange an appointment with one of the GPs in the practice by phoning at any time of the working day, or you can attend in person to make an appointment.

You may choose a face to face consultation or a telephone consultation according to your preference and appointments may be made up to a week in advance.

If urgent it is possible to obtain same day appointments, subject to availability.

Text messaging

We are using text messaging increasingly to allow better access to other services for example immunisations, smear tests and repeat blood tests. This allows patients to book their own appointments by replying to messages from us on a smart phone.

Home Visits

If someone is too ill to come to the surgery, a home visit can be requested.

Home visits are reserved for those who are housebound or too ill to go out. The doctor will phone you to discuss your request and the most seriously ill patients will be visited first. Transport difficulties are not an appropriate reason for a home visit.
